We have multiple items to accomplish including rebuilding a few boardwalks (you can help with carrying lumber if able), removing small saplings from our trail meadows, clearing brush and downed trees on trails, removing invasive plants, and spreading wood chips.

Please bring work gloves...and if you have them, clippers or loppers to trim small branches and saplings, electric or gas powered brush cutter and steel rakes (for spreading wood chips). Also be sure to wear sturdy shoes, long pants/sleeves and if desired, insect repellent (to deter black flies and ticks).
