

#### From the Desk of the First Selectman:

#### Dear Willington Residents:

Willington is usually a great place to be in the fall, and we are really hoping that this year is more peaceful than last year. Tropical Storm Irene hit at the beginning of the season and our autumn ended with the freak October snowstorm, Alfred. These storms left us with road closures and power outages and many people are still cleaning up from them. The good news is that if we do see severe weather like that again, we will be prepared thanks to the efforts of our Emergency Services Team.

Our Emergency Services Team consists of: Emergency Management Director, Stuart Cobb; Fire Chief, Tyler Millix; Fire Chief, Tom Snyder; CERT Team Leader, Kelly Trueb; Public Works Director, Lynn Nicholls; Animal Control Officer, Tina Binheimer; Superintendent, David Harding; Selectmen's Administrative Assistant, Robin Campbell; and myself. These people represent a number of other people who volunteer for the Town as Firefighters, EMTs, CERT Team members and also town employees, such as our Public Works and Town Office employees. Many of these people gave up a weekend in July to participate in the statewide hurricane drill and went through the process of working with state agencies and utilities such as CL&P to think through processes and procedures in the event of a major disaster. Because we had some practice in this area, our team did very well and we managed to learn a lot and find ways to improve our response. I would like to thank our Emergency Services Team for their dedication to the safety of our residents and for their continued commitment.

#### PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION INFORMATION

The Registrars of Voters in Willington want to remind everyone intending to vote in the upcoming Presidential & State Election (November 6, 2012) to plan ahead and make sure you are registered in your **town** of residence well ahead of



the deadline. Registering to vote is an easy process and there are several methods for obtaining a voter application form.

- Applications can be downloaded from the Secretary of the State's website: www.ct.gov/sots or Willington's website: www.willingtonct.org. Once you have filled in the application, print and sign it then mail it to the Registrars of Voters, 40 Old Farms Rd, Willington, CT 06279. Mail in application must be postmarked by October 23.
- The Registrars of all towns in Connecticut will hold special Voter Registration Sessions on the following dates:
  - Saturday, October 20, 2012, from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm
  - Tuesday, October 30, 2012, from 9:00 am until 8:00 pm (deadline to register in person)




