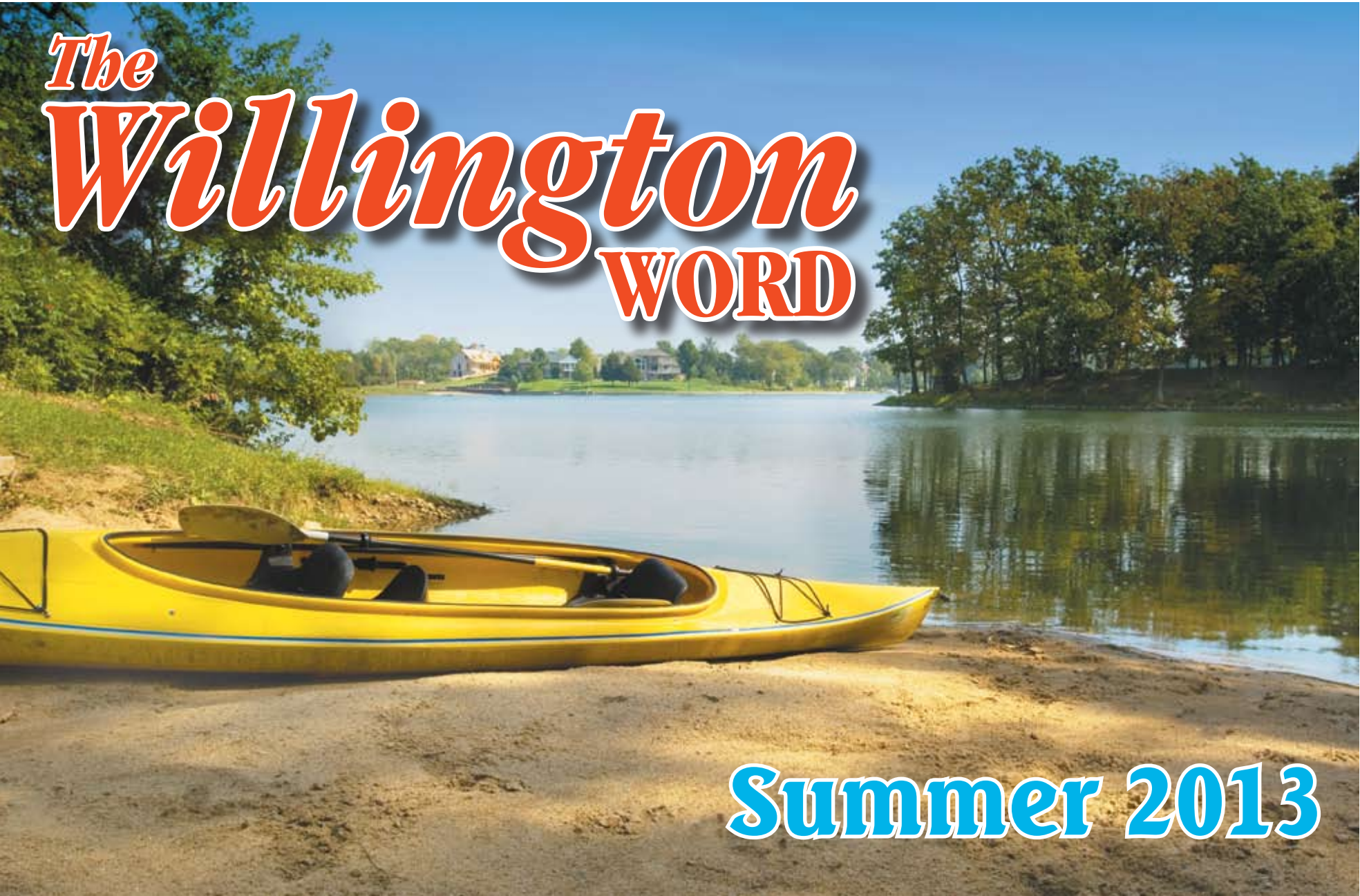

### FRIENDLY REMINDER

This is a reminder to Willington taxpayers that the first installment of taxes billed in July 2013, on the assessment list of October 1, 2012, are due in full by August 1, 2013. After this date, the tax becomes delinquent and interest will be charged at a rate of 1 ½% per month (\$2.00 minimum), starting at 3% on August 2, 2013.

You can pay your tax bills in person at the Tax Collector's office in the Town Office Building, 40 Old Farms Rd. Public hours are Mon. 12:30 p.m.-7:30 p.m., Tues. through Fri. 9:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m. If these hours are inconvenient, please use the payment drop box installed outside the Town Office Building.

If paying in person or using drop box, to avoid interest, you must do so **before** the close of business on August 1ST. We will check the drop box at closing time on August 1ST. We are closed July 4, 2013 & July 5, 2013 for the Holiday.

You can mail your tax payment using the green envelope enclosed with your tax bill. If you are requesting a receipt, please be sure to enclose a self addressed stamped envelope along with your payment. You must have your envelope post marked by August 1, 2013 to avoid paying interest.

You may also pay by credit card by calling 1-800-272-9829 or on line at [www.officialpayments.com](http://www.officialpayments.com). Willington's jurisdiction code is 1707.

**NEW: You can now look up your bills on line by going to "willingtonct.org" - Go to Town Depts. - Go to Revenue Collection Dept. -Click on link "view my tax bill". Type in last name - search and you will be able to see your bills.**

## From the Desk of the Town Clerk

### Dog Licenses

June is the time to register your dog. You will receive renewal reminders at the end of May 2013. There is fee of \$8.00 for a spayed/neutered dog and a \$19.00 fee for

male/female dog. You can license your dog in person or by mail. All dog license requests must be received in this office in person or in the office via the mail by June 30th. An updated rabies certificate, if not current is required, a check payable to the Willington Town Clerk and a **self addressed, stamped envelope should be included**, if by mail. New dogs being registered would need the rabies certificate, spayed/neutered papers, check payable to Willington Town Clerk and a self addressed, stamped envelope, if mailed, for us to process your license. Please register your dog in June to avoid additional late fees as of July 1st. There is a \$1.00 per month and \$1.00each additional month per state statute.



### Passports

Passports are no longer processed in our office due to new government regulations. Forms are available online at [pptctcm@state.gov](mailto:pptctcm@state.gov) Get your passport, as soon as possible, if you know you will be traveling. An approximate processing time is about 4 weeks to 6 weeks. The Probate Judge's Office in Tolland or the Storrs Post Office processes passports. The Probate Judge's telephone number is 860 871-3640 or the Storrs Post Office is 860 429-9681.

### Notary Services

We are Notary Publics and can notarize documents. We will not notarize any documents that will be filed on the town land records or persons wills. There is a \$5.00 fee for this service.

## Prescription Drug Discount Program

Willington signs up for new, free Prescription Drug Discount Program offered by the Connecticut Conference of Municipalities for residents of its member towns and cities.

The Town of Willington, through its association with the Connecticut Conference of Municipalities (CCM), the statewide association of towns and cities, is now providing a new prescription discount card that will provide uninsured and underinsured residents steep savings on prescription medicines.

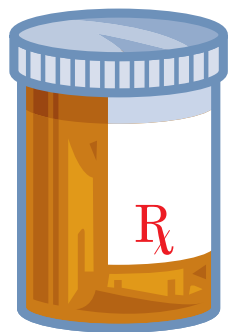
The "Town of Willington Prescription Drug Discount Card" helps residents save money on their prescription medications any time their prescription is not covered by insurance. This new prescription discount card will provide immediate fiscal relief at the pharmacy counter for uninsured and underinsured residents and offers the following features and benefits:

- Anyone can participate regardless of age or income;
- All prescription medications are covered including pet prescriptions that can be filled at a pharmacy;
- There is no cost to the municipality or to participating residents;
- Cost savings average 45%;
- There are over 63,000 participating pharmacies nationwide, including CVS, Rite-Aid, Walgreens, Wal-Mart, Stop and Shop, and Big Y, and many independent pharmacies;
- Discounts are also offered on other medical services including vision, hearing and Lasik services.

Each residence in Willington receive a "Town of Willington Prescription Discount Card" by mail in early May which they may

use at any participating retail pharmacy. Cards may be used by all town residents regardless of age, income or existing health coverage. There are no enrollment forms, membership fees, restrictions or limits on frequency of use

for residents. Cardholders and their family members are encouraged to use the cards any time their prescriptions are not covered by insurance. Cards will also be printed by visiting [www.CTRxDiscountCard.com](http://www.CTRxDiscountCard.com), and selecting Willington from the drop-down menu or by picking one up at the Town Office Building.

## Kayak Loaner Program

**TOWN OF WILLINGTON PARKS & RECREATION**  
Policy & Procedures for Free Kayak Loaner Program

The Willington Parks and Recreation Department has obtained Kayak Equipment through a grant from Eastern Highlands Health District initiative "Healthy Eating, Active Living" (HEAL). All rentals include one life jacket and one paddle per kayak.

**Reservations are a must: Loaner equipment is available Monday-Friday by appointment. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance.**

**Only one open reservation will be allowed per household.** 24 hour rental unless equipment is available May 15, 2012 - October 15:

Pickup 9:15 am Tuesday –Friday

Pickup; Mondays is 12:45 pm - Drop off 9:15 am the following morning (unless a weekend then drop off is Monday at 12:45)

**All loading and unloading of the kayaks is the sole responsibility of the renter.**

**Call (860) 487-3108 during office hours:** Monday 12:30 -7:30 pm; Tuesday- Friday 9:00 am – 2:00 pm, to schedule an appointment. Check in & check out location is at Town Office Building, 40 Old Farms Road.

**Equipment Condition:** Loaner will be assessed all repair or replacement fees for damaged equipment as per loan agreement. Patrons who develop a trend of misuse will be denied further use. Pre and post inspections will be conducted and signed for by the patron and on-duty attendant.

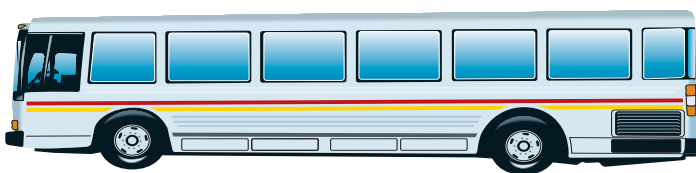
