
ITEM IV


To see if the townspeople, on the recommendation of the Board of Selectmen, will adopt the Capital Improvement Program for fiscal years 2019 to 2023.

To see if the townspeople, on the recommendation of the Board of Finance will appropriate \$12,500 from the Capital Projects Fund-LoCIP- RRAC Parking Lot lights and Surveillance for the purpose of installing lighting and a surveillance camera at RRAC to be reimbursed by the State of Connecticut Local Capital Improvement Program.
