

Knowlton Hill Preserve

Knowlton Hill Preserve is a 127-acre parcel that was given to the Trust by Mildred Hammon-Knowlton and her niece Evelyn Guyon over a period of years in the 1980's and 1990's.

The preserve includes woodlands and hayfields and crests a magnificent glacial drumlin from which there is a commanding view of the Mount Hope River valley and Knowlton Pond.

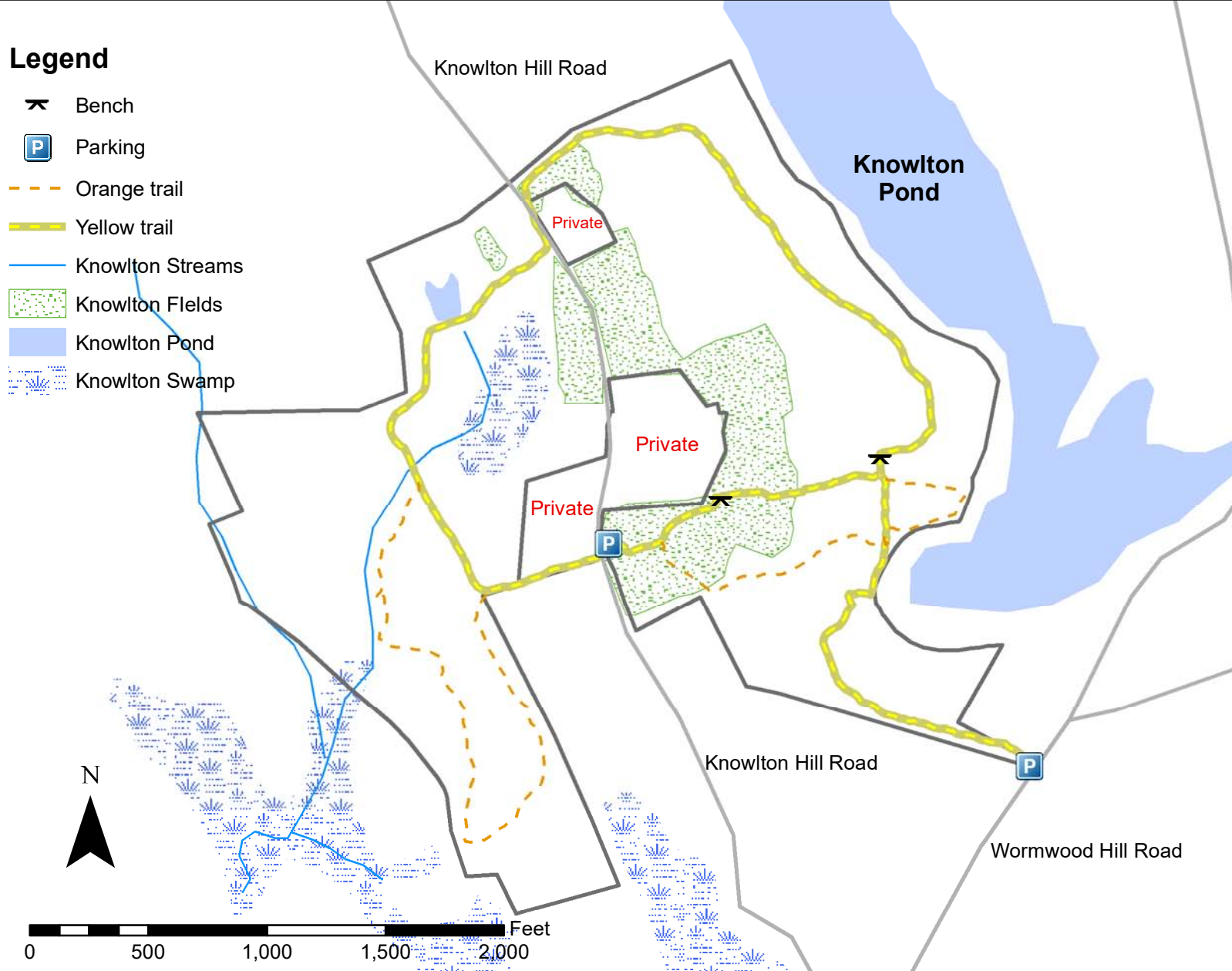

NO: motor vehicles, horses, fires, or camping

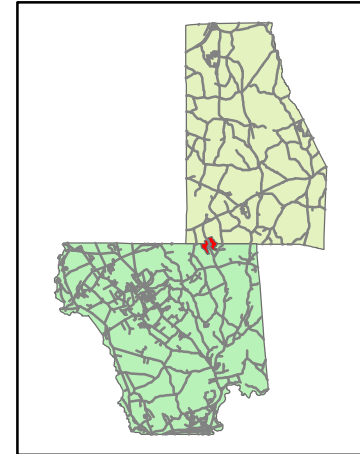
