Furthermore, sun exposure is the number one cause of skin cancer. There are many factors that contribute to issues from the sun's rays, so even if your skin normally tans, you are still vulnerable! I wear 50+ SPF sunscreen every day during these sunny months and I urge you to use a sunscreen of 30+ SPF, even if you'll only be outside for a short time. Protect your eyes with sunglasses, as the sun can also damage your eyes. Your skin, your eyes, and your health will thank you!


